WHY HIDE IS BETTER?

Not all contractors are aware that Australian Pool Safety Standards have changed, and a loose stone skimmer lid is most often **NOT compliant**, and **NOT pool safe**. The traditional plastic option also has serious drawbacks - many homeowners replace it with a HIDE cover.

- cheap looking finish which is raised, bulky and often quickly discolours in the sun
- $\ensuremath{\bigotimes}$ the lid colour can't be matched to the paving, and grout lines are interrupted
- the raised lid can be a trip hazard, especially for young children
- requires regular replacement due to sun exposure, which makes the plastic brittle and susceptible to cracks and breakage
- requires regular replacement due to constant load-bearing damage if it is located on a main walkway around the pool

LOOSE STONE/

TILE OPTION



- compliance issues mean young children are at risk of serious harm
- cheap looking finish with large holes, interrupted grout lines and the stone often doesn't sit flush with the surrounds
- \bowtie with use, the loose stone is chipped, cracked or broken, plus can damage the surrounds
- when broken, matching new stone to existing stone is difficult, as batches change or are discontinued
- a contractor has to be recalled, usually at the homeowners expense, to match, cut + fit a new stone (which remains non-compliant)
